AWHONN NC Section is pleased to announce the **Call for Poster Abstracts** for our 2023 Annual Conference. NC AWHONN advances the NC nursing profession by promoting the health of women and newborns by providing critical information and support to assist in the delivery of best practices and high quality of care. Posters should focus on one or more of the following:

- educate/inform attendees about innovative initiatives in your facility
- present research designed to enhance quality care
- present evidence-informed or evidence-based practices that impact women’s health, maternal and/or neonatal outcomes

Submission Guidelines:

1. Abstracts must be submitted via email northcarolina@awhonnsection.org with “NC AWHONN Abstract” on subject line
2. Reviews will be blinded. Please do not include any identifying information in the abstract. Removal of all personal information before committee views abstracts will occur. If any identifying information is found in the body of the abstract, it will not be reviewed by committee. Notice of acceptance will be sent by December 15th, 2022.
3. General Format including:
 - Session Title
 - In 300 words or less, provide a summary of proposed presentation including background, purpose or aim, description of topic (methods, findings, methodology), and any clinical implications or conclusion.
 - List three (3) measureable objectives. If applicable, include clinical implications for the learner.

Poster Presentation of Abstract at Conference:

Poster presenters should be registered to attend the conference. Primary poster presenters are eligible to receive a \$40 discount off main conference registration fee. Only one discount per poster presentation. No travel or other expenses are provided. Presenters are responsible for all expenses incurred for their presentation including, but not limited to, the poster itself.

Poster presenters should be present at their poster display for at least a portion of assigned poster presentation times to allow colleagues to ask questions. Exact times are subject to the final program and will be communicated to all presenters.

Participants will be provided with easel, presentation board, and clips to display posters. These boards measure **36”x48”**, which will be the expected size of poster. You may bring handouts or other material that you feel would be appropriate to share with conference attendees. We are planning for 350 participants.
